- Provides structure and routine




Research Proves

- 7.5 hours per day for 180 days = 1350 hours
- Average parent(s) get home at 5 P.M. Average student goes to bed at 10 P.M. 5 hours per day for 180 days = 900 hours
- Students spend approximately 450 more hours with teachers!
